

D'Arbonne Range Riders Organizational Rules

1. Have fun and be courteous and considerate.
2. Any member of the organization may be reprimanded up to and including termination of membership and being permanently barred from the D'Arbonne Range Riders for any of the following offenses:
 - a. Fighting or quarreling in the arena or on the grounds
 - b. Conduct, speech, or anything detrimental to the best interest of the D'Arbonne Range Riders
 - c. Failure to abide by or disobedience of articles, by-laws, and/or rules of the D'Arbonne Range Riders
 - d. Suing or attempting to sue the D'Arbonne Range Riders.
3. No all-terrain vehicles on the grounds without written consent from the D'Arbonne Range Riders Board.
4. No open carry of firearms on the premises.
5. Twelve (12) months negative coggins test required for any horse brought on the grounds.
6. Yield to horses.
7. Abuse of a horse will not be tolerated. An executive committee of three (3) board members will make a determination.
8. The arena marshall's decision is final.
9. Adults will be responsible for their horses and their children.
10. No stallions shall be left on the grounds unattended at any time.
11. No horse should be tied to fences at the rear of the arena.
12. Dogs should be on a leash in common areas.
13. Voting age for elections and motions is eighteen (18) years.
14. No horses may be left on the property under any circumstances without written permission from the D'Arbonne Range Riders Board.
15. No member shall use the facility for personal or commercial profit without written permission from the D'Arbonne Range Riders Board.
16. Gate codes are for D'Arbonne Range Riders members only. Members may bring 2 guests and must be present at all times. After two visits, guests must buy their own membership.
17. The board will expect the cooperation of any member when called upon by the riding club officials to represent the riding club's interest regarding enforcement of the rules in any matter of official business.
